Recip foot / pipe clamp not locking due to buildup of debris under cover / in orifices Heavily contaminated tool holder Bent, damaged and broken feet



Adjustable foot mechanism retaining bolt loose (circled)



Screws – have been loose, missing and / or incorrect for application





100% check as part of combined inspection and test:
Peel back / removal of boot to allow inspection of casing, retaining bolts / screws and
foot security / adjusting mechanism. Consider threadlock for fasteners where
appropriate.
