What is Energy Procurement?

What is the process?

- 1 Free Energy Consultation**

- 3 Analysis**
During this stage, the energy consultant will present an overview of the findings, your available options and their expert analysis.
- 4 Strategy Selection**
This is where you come in! You will work together to define the best course of action moving forward, but ultimately, the decision is yours.
- 5 Tender & Live Negotiation**
The consultants will work with the energy suppliers to test the market and negotiate the available options, based on the live wholesale market.
- 6 Presentation of the Contract**
Now we have found the best deals available, you will be presented with the various options and recommendations. Bear in mind, **tender prices are only available until close of market (4pm) each day.**
- 7 Contract Signature**
It is time to lock it in! You will receive a contract via DocuSign to lock in your rates. **To secure the rate, it must be completed ahead of the market closing at 4pm.**
- 8 Sit back and relax**
DBG will handle all requirements moving forward, including supplier management, account management and customer care.
